## CONGRATULATIONS TO JESSE McCORMACK and JOSHUA LUSH

Joshua and Jesse competed in the **2011 Queensland Underage AWD State Championships** in Brisbane last weekend. Not only did they win many gold medals and set new Games Records, they also secured the Champion Region for Cairns. Although they were the only two athletes from Cairns competing, they were able to outscore other regions with greater number of athletes, a testament to the commitment shown by both athletes. Jesse also placed second in the Male Athlete of the carnival, along with setting a new National record for the U14 Javelin with a throw of 27.46m.

Joshua is currently in Darwin competing in the National Primary School Championships and we wish him well in his events.
